# 9. AGENDA ITEMS & ISSUES TABLED FOR DEBATE

- Sustainability: IAck has updated the approved materials list recently.
- **Sharing Good Practice:** SEJAG have been discussing the potential for further sessions of the defect training.
- **Performance**: Balanced scorecard was discussed & DL to check with Geoplace whether a Regional Scorecard is available (NB: Geoplace have confirmed it is not available Regionally at present). SEHAUC have been copied in on correspondence between Southern Water & Brighton & Hove CC, regarding a reinstatement performance issue. Island Roads have put Openreach on an Improvement notice, and BB has submitted the improvement plan. Prosecutions at HAUC(England) level there is no requirement to report to Secretariat, but there is an agenda item. Coring DL mentioned that a number of promoters are now in the mid to high 80's compliance levels.
- HAUC(UK): HAUC (England) Sector Agreed Conditions Document DL/PL have now put signed document on the HAUC(UK) website. Kent CC will accept the new conditions, provided they are relevant to the permit. Surrey/ESCC will only accept SEPS conditions at present and are looking at working towards acceptance of the Sector Agreed Conditions next year. Bracknell Forest are using the National Conditions, but are receiving conditions relating to SEPS Model conditions which is causing confusion.
- Venues for future meetings: Oakwood House for March 2015. BB awaiting from some HA's regarding dates for the yearly planner.
