TERMS OF REFERENCE

These are only to apply to the particular specialist areas which the Sub-Groups cover.

1. To address those issues referred to the group by SEHAUC.
2. To advise SEHAUC on the implementation of national policies.
3. To assist SEHAUC in the resolution of disputes.
4. To monitor performance.

CONSTITUTION

1. The members shall comprise of representatives from both the highway authorities and the utilities.
2. The Chairman shall be a member of SEHAUC. The Sub-Group will make its own arrangements for the appointment of a Secretary.
3. The frequency of meetings will be agreed within the sub-group but should be of sufficient frequency to meet the targets set by SEHAUC.
